NEW AMBASSADORS TO HELP SPREAD THE ANZAC SPIRIT

Mr Dominello said the new Ambassadors have a range of skills and experience and all share a commitment to the Anzac tradition.

"These new Ambassadors join the 26 members of the NSW Anzac Advisory Council announced last year.

"All the Ambassadors will help the community embrace the spirit of the commemorations by taking part in local, regional and state events throughout 2014 – 2018.

"The Centenary of Anzac is a momentous occasion and our team is working hard to ensure the NSW commemorations honour the sacrifice of our servicemen and women," Mr Dominello said.

General Cosgrove said the new Ambassadors were selected for their demonstrated commitment to community service and connection to the Anzac tradition.
